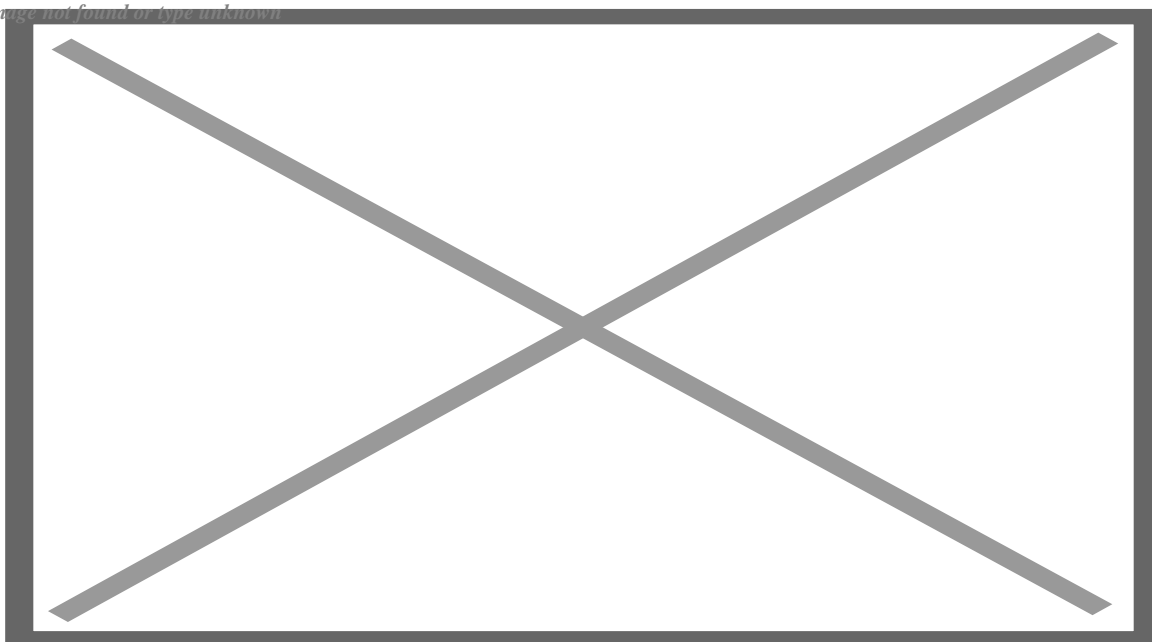


Gala ceremony for the 75th anniversary National Ballet of Cuba

National Ballet of Cuba: 75 Years of Miracle

Havana, Oct 29 (RHC) The greatness of the National Ballet of Cuba (BNC) stood out in the gala ceremony for its 75th anniversary, with the performance of young ballet dancers and acclaimed professionals under the BNC founders' symbolic gaze.
