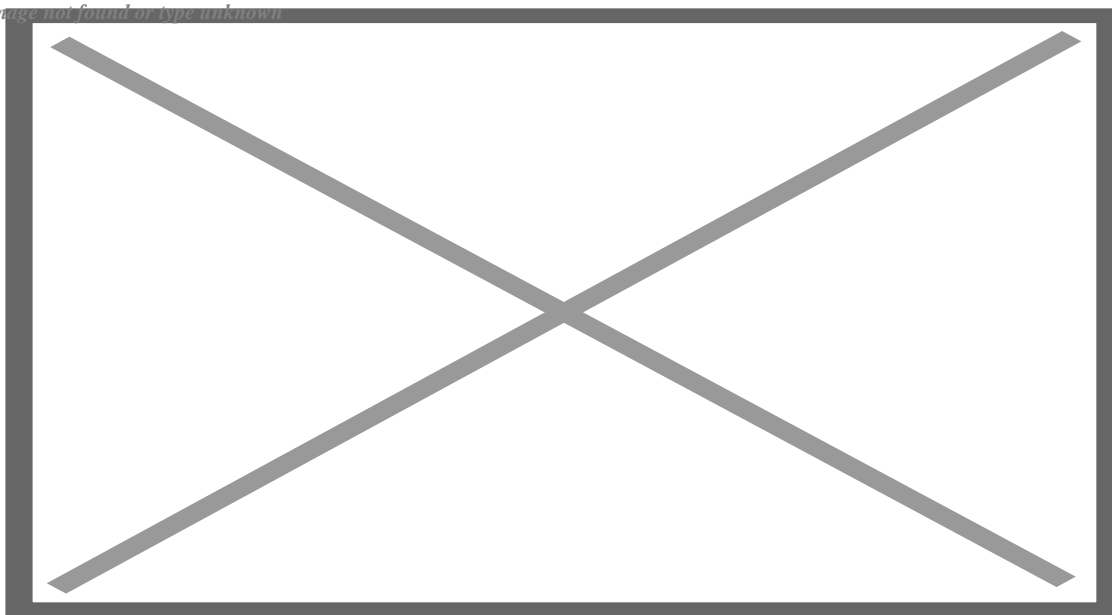


Cuba's top leadership accompanies youth march in solidarity with Palestine
