
Cuban president praised meeting with his Brazilian counterpart



Havana, Dec 2 (RHC) Cuban president Miguel Díaz-Canel praised this Saturday the meeting with his Brazilian counterpart, Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva, in the context of the summit of the Group of 77

in the COP28.
