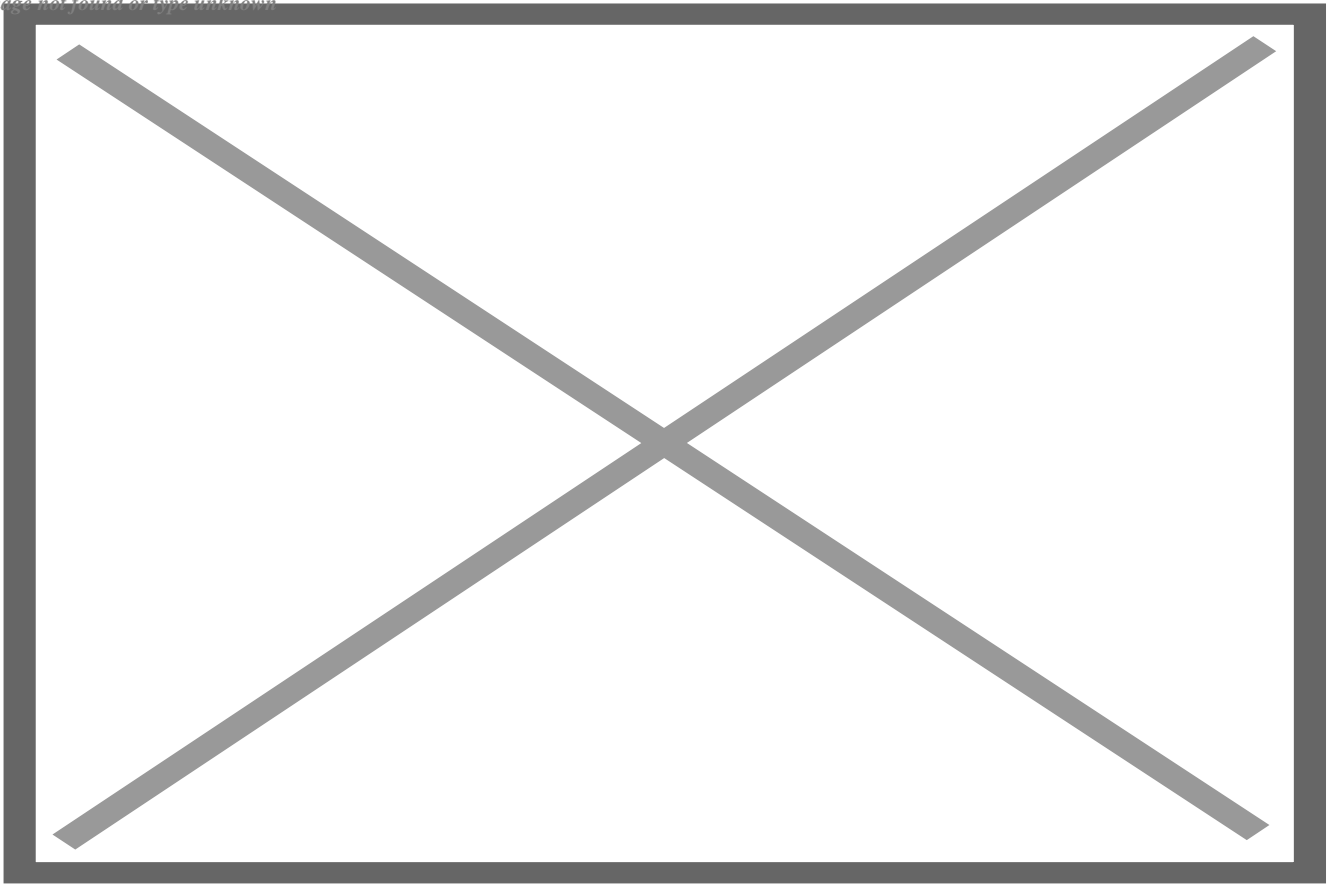


Díaz-Canel chairs Plenary Session of the Cuban Communist Party

Havana, December 15 (RHC) -- The First Secretary of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Cuba (CC-PCC) and President of the Republic, Miguel Díaz-Canel heads this Friday the 7th Plenary Session of the Central Committee of that political organization, which will be in session until tomorrow in this capital.

In its profile on the social network X, the PCC stated that the meeting will analyze priority political, economic and social issues of the country.

The meeting was preceded by a broad consultation process of the documents to be studied, aimed at facing the country's complex economic situation.

Also, the forum will analyze the political-ideological work in compliance with the ideas, concepts and guidelines emanating from the 8th Congress of the PCC, held in April 2021.

Likewise, the actions and protocols established in terms of attention to gender violence will be evaluated, as this is a social problem.

As has happened in previous plenary sessions, the Political Bureau of the CC-PCC will report on its work since the last event of this kind (Source: Prensa Latina).
