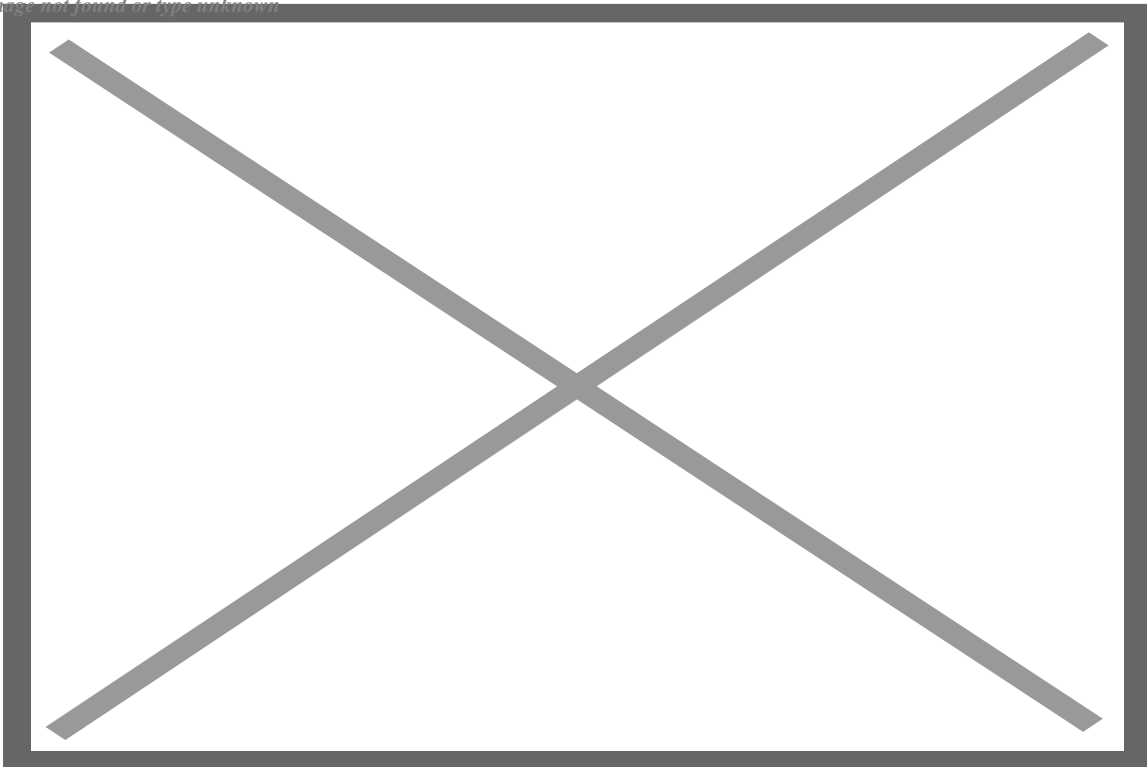


Crocodiles Bite Cazadores in Cuban Baseball
