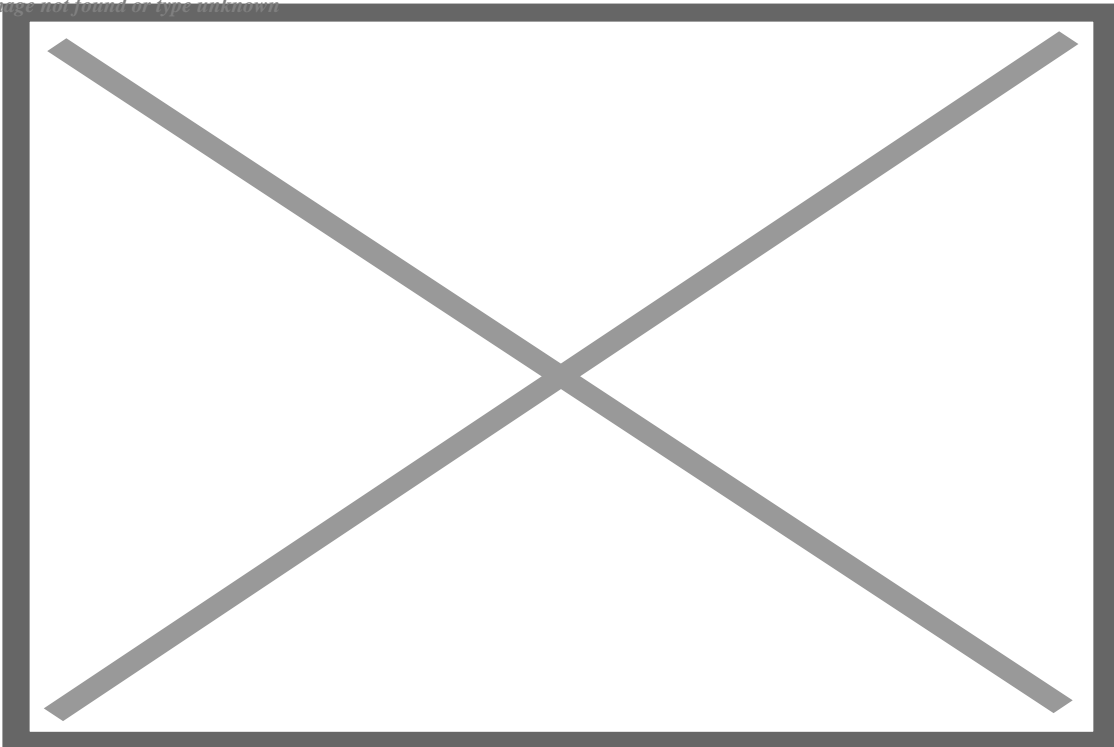


Foreign journalists visit the Fidel Castro Center

Foreign journalists will visit the Fidel Castro Center

Havana, Jan 23 (RHC) Communication professionals from more than 30 countries visit the Fidel Castro Ruz Center today, as the culmination of the program of the international conference New Operation Truth.

The journalists will tour the exhibition halls of the venue that describes part of the work of the historical leader of the Cuban Revolution.

Fidel Castro's visionary thinking was taken up by the panelists and attendees at the forum of journalists and communicators, who debated issues related to the new international information order, news in times of the Internet, and news agencies in times of hypermedia.

Cuban president Miguel Díaz-Canel participated in the academic dialogue, convened by the Latin American Information Agency Prensa Latina on the 65th anniversary of Operation Truth, a conference with international journalists organized by Fidel Castro on a similar date in 1959.

In that context, the nascent Cuban revolutionary project resisted a fierce discredit campaign orchestrated from the United States, on the occasion of the trials carried out against criminals and torturers of the tyranny of Fulgencio Batista (1952-1958). (Source: PL)
