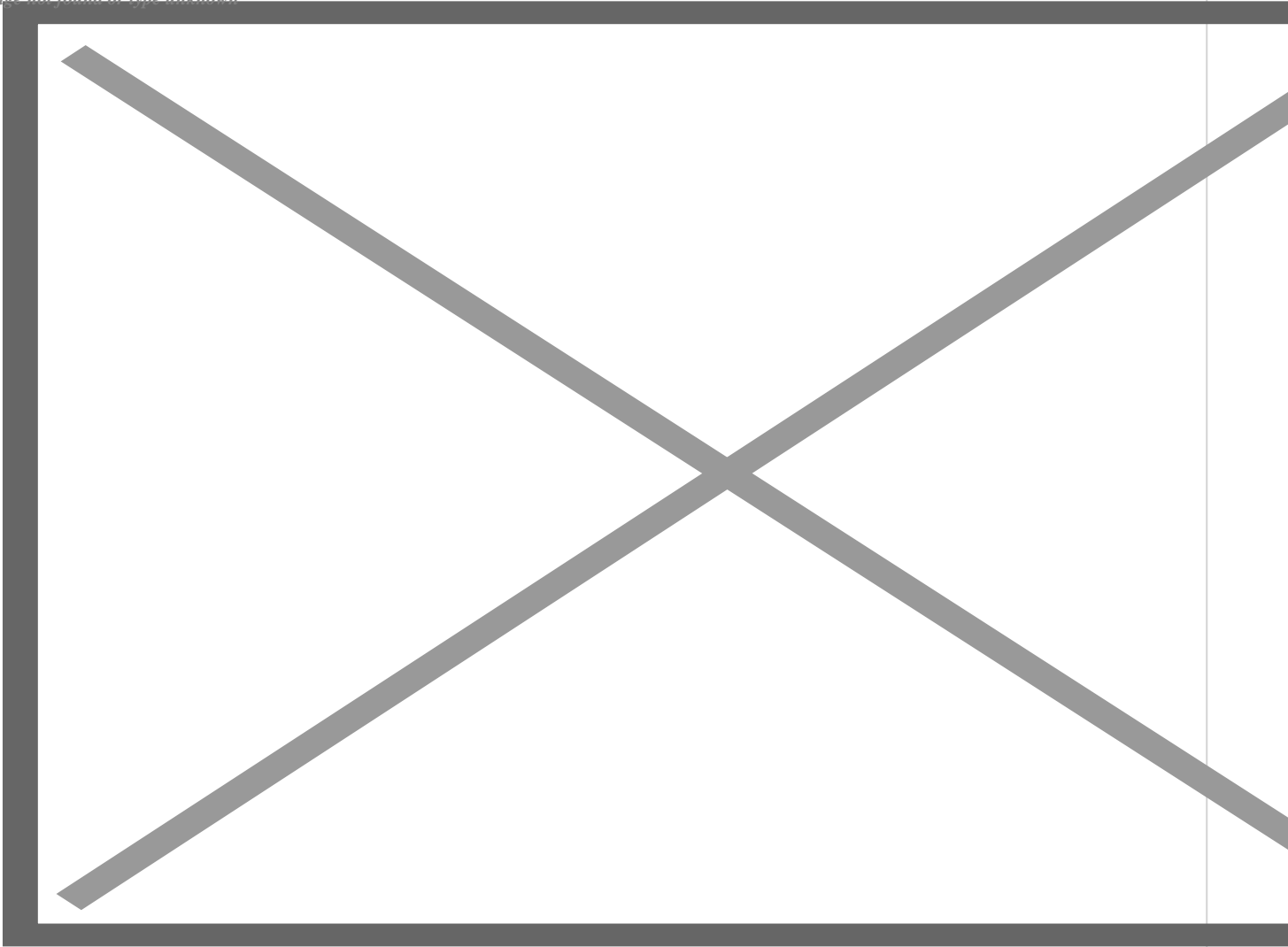


Cuba's Habano Festival closes successfully

Havana, March 1 (RHC) The 24th Habano Festival closes its doors today, described as successful by its 2,900 attendees from 108 nations.
