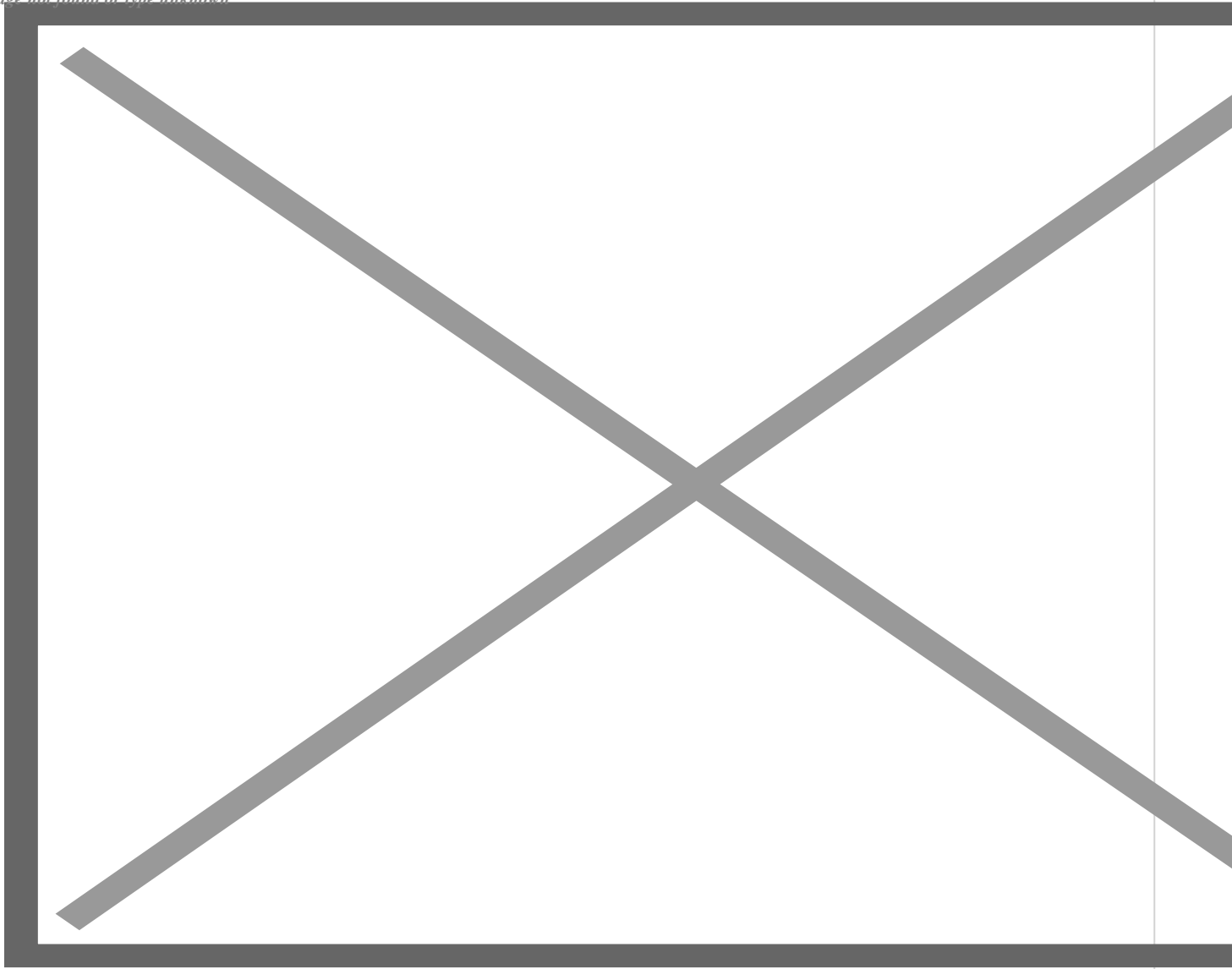


Cuba thanks donation from Saint Vincent and the Grenadines
