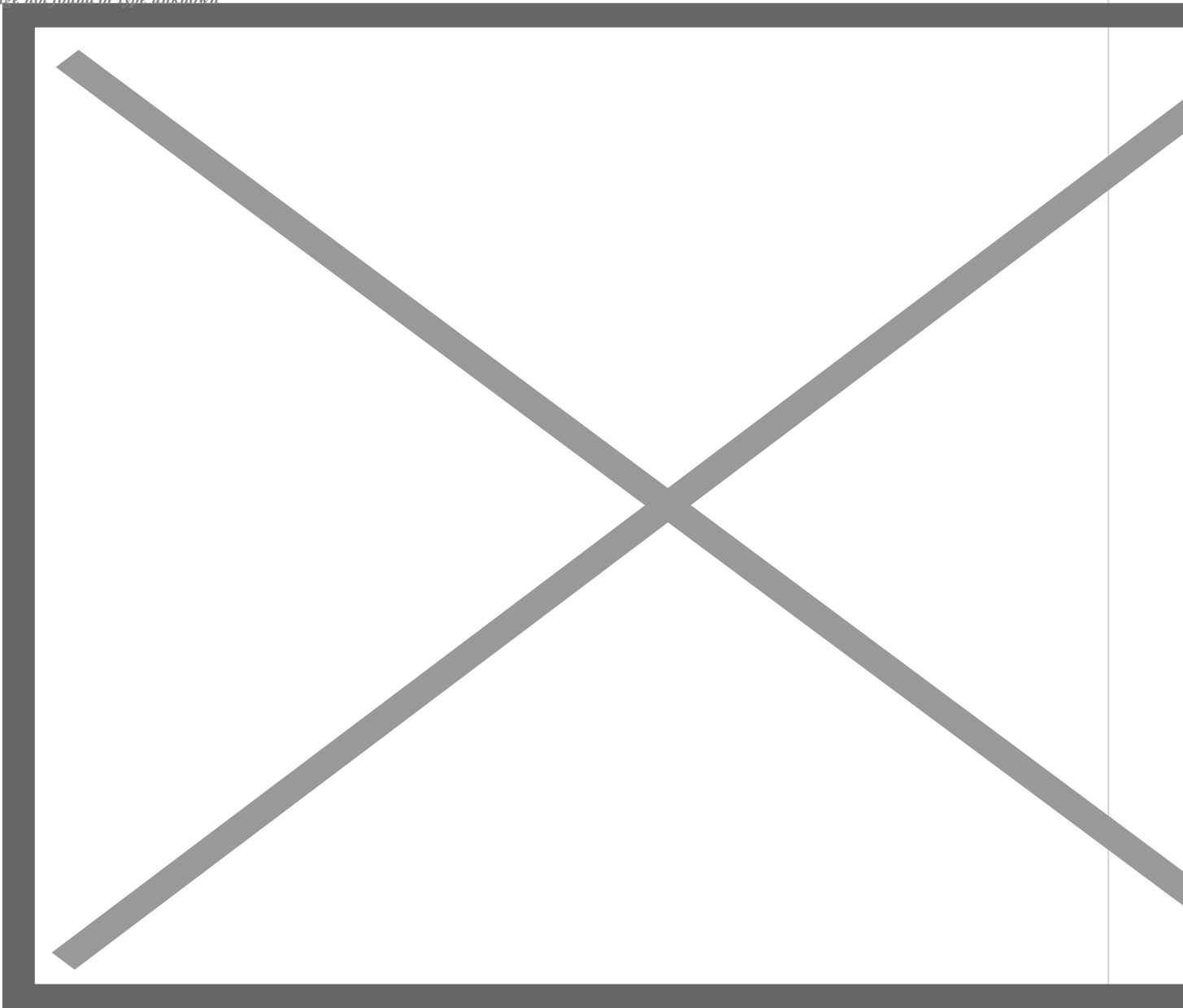


Cuban ambassador and Sri Lankan business group dialogue
