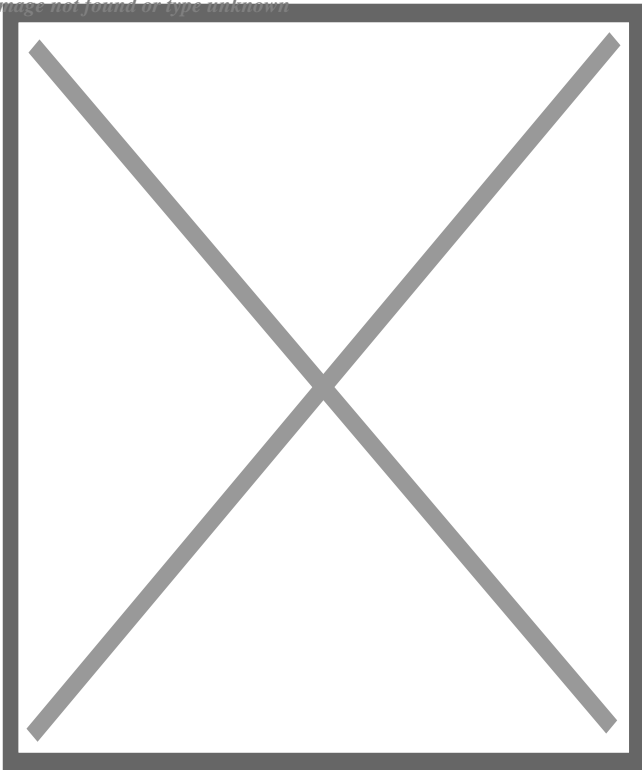


Israeli historian Ilan Pappé interrogated by U.S. agents at Detroit airport
