

Cuban president holds meeting with young Americans in Havana

Havana, June 11 (RHC)-- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel shared with more than 100 young people from the American Let Cuba Live Brigade, who are carrying out a solidarity visit with the cause of Cuba and Palestine, an official source reported this Tuesday.

The Cuban leader announced that in his podcast From the Presidency that will be published this week - the president's informative space on YouTube - the public will be able to learn about those experiences recounted by the protagonists themselves.

Díaz-Canel described as “admirable” the young people who, he said, are making revolution “in the belly of the beast.”

In another tweet, the head of state appeared in photos among the young Americans and with a message in which he expressed: “Palestine hurts, and it has to hurt us every day that we don't do something for it. That is where the global fight for justice and dignity is defined today.”

In the publication, the Cuban president also warned that “the weight of history will fall on those who insist on remaining indifferent to the massacre committed by the Israeli army in the occupied Palestinian territories.
