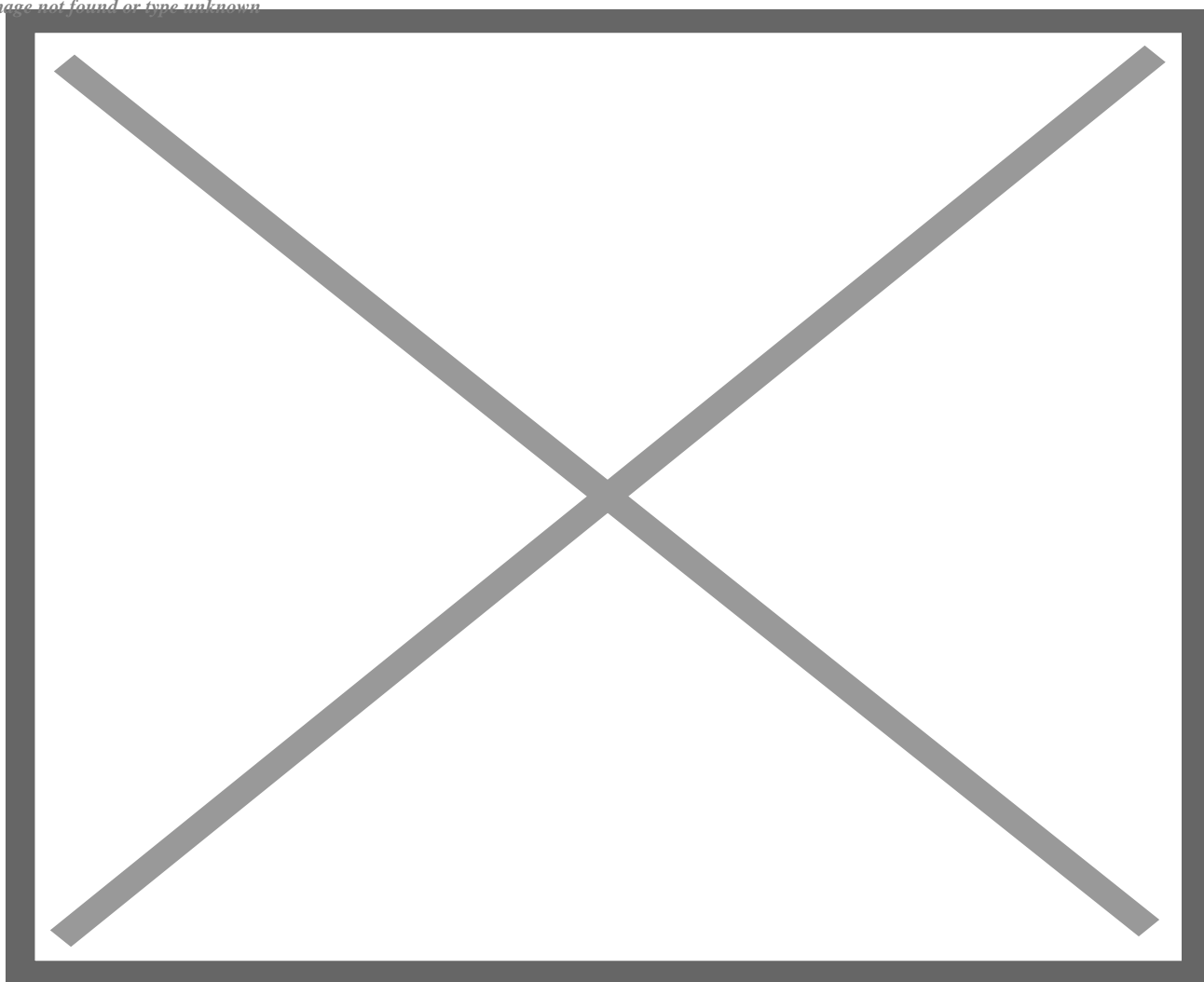


Cuban foreign minister congratulates the International Press Center
