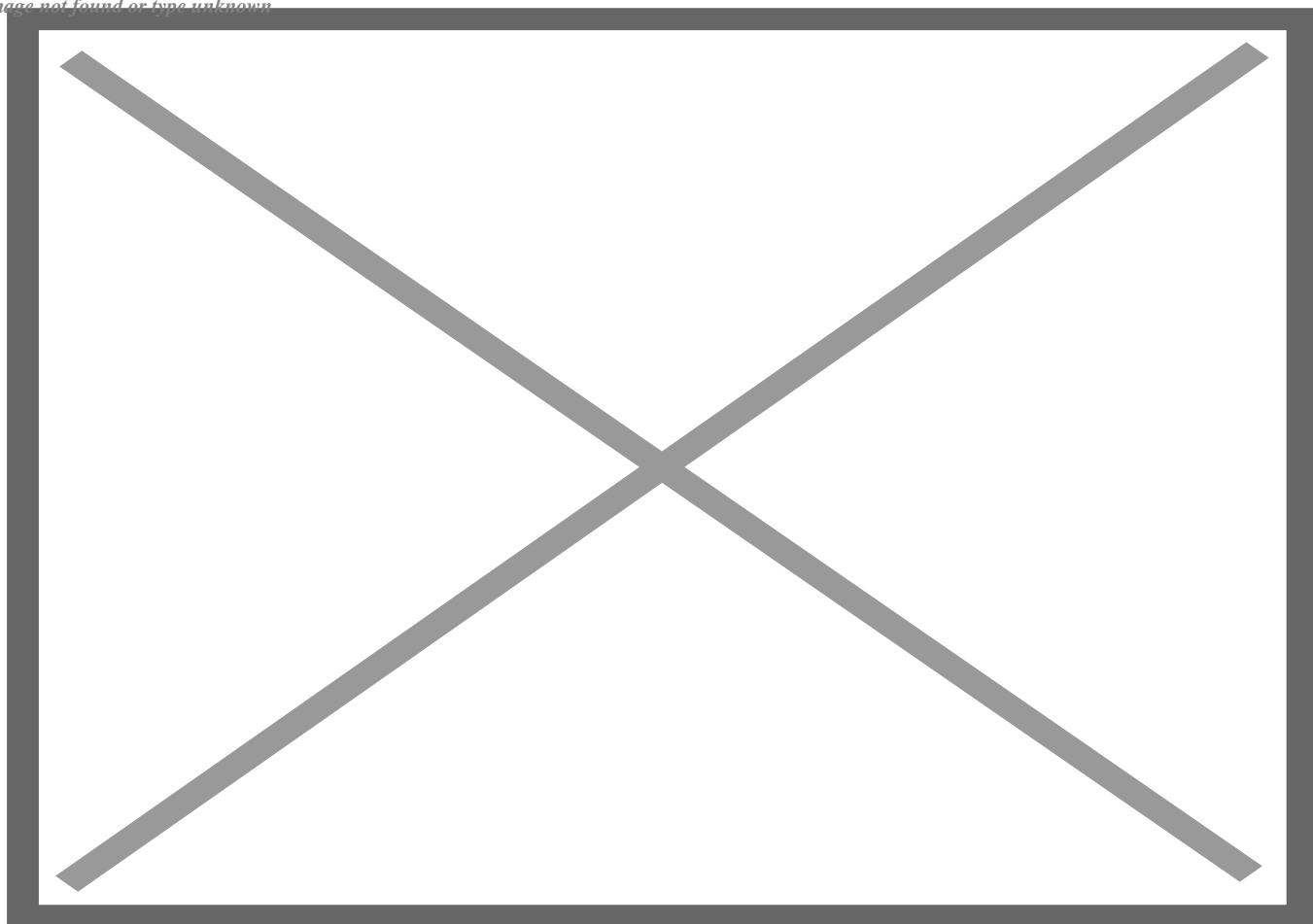


Food production and crime control on the agenda of the VIII Plenary Session of the Central Committee of the Party
