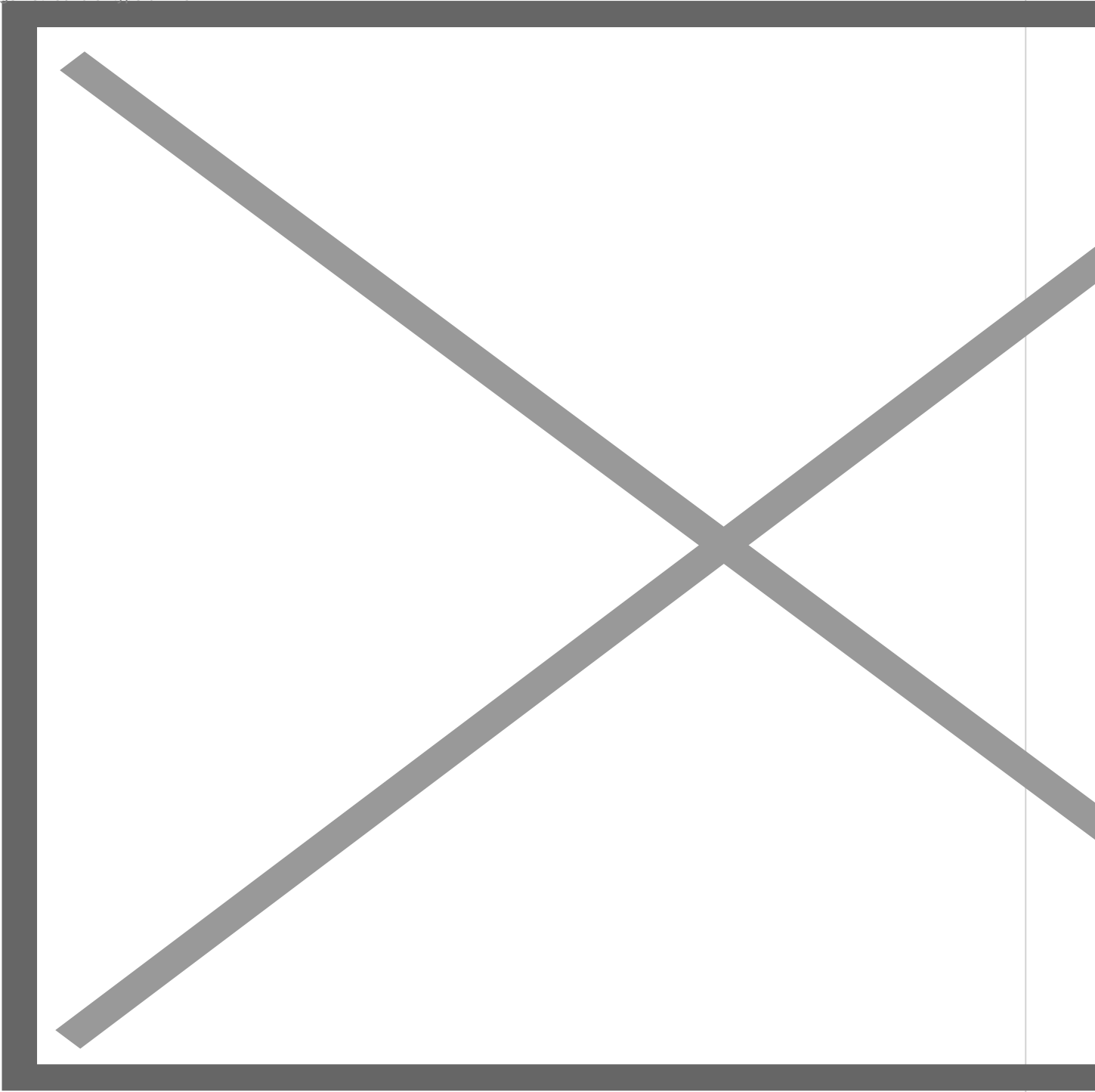

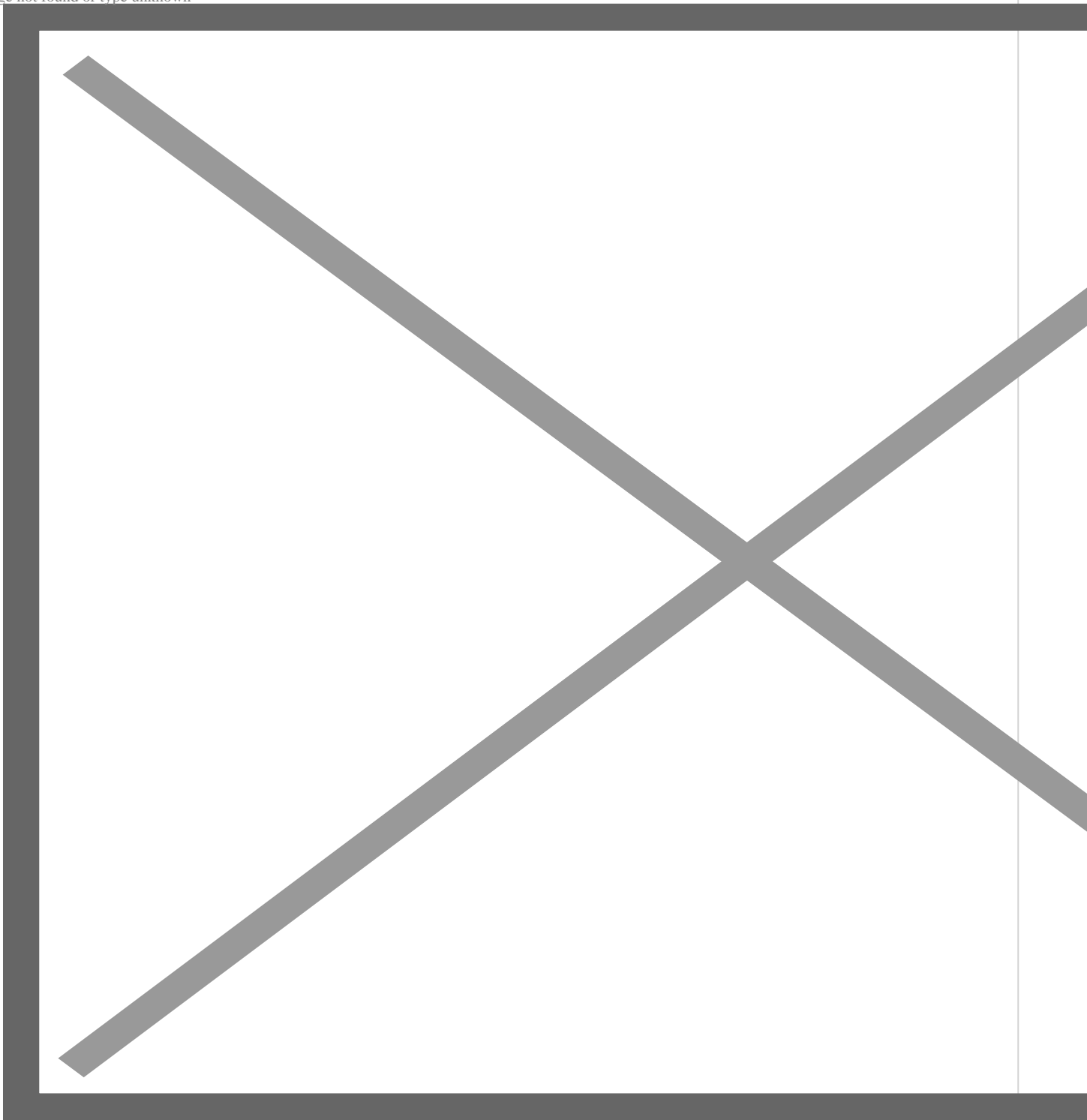
Mexico City, June 25 (RHC)-- Mexican President Andrés Manuel López Obrador celebrated the release of Julian Assange from prison in London.
