

Electronic Voting in Peru More Transparent, Efficient and Less Costly



Lima, October 8 (Andina-RHC) --Electronic voting was successfully implemented in several districts in the recent Peru municipal and regional elections, paving the way for greater citizen participation in the democratic process, analysts said.

With this initiative, Peru is at the forefront of the countries in Latin America looking at their electoral reforms.

"Supported by ScytI, a worldwide leader in secure online voting and election modernization, the National Office of Electoral Processes (ONPE) was able to deliver Peruvian citizens a more secure, transparent and modern electoral system this year." a spokesman said.

The initiative was implemented in seven districts and covered over 85 percent of eligible voters.
