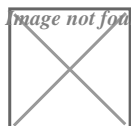


Yusneylis Guzman and Gabriel Rosillo will go for bronze

Paris, Aug 6 (ACN) Yusneylis Guzmán López, Cuban wrestler in the -50 kilograms division, fell today (0-5) in her semifinal match and will be fighting for the bronze medal in the XXXIII edition of the Olympic Games.

Guzman Lopez could not impose his rhythm against the Indian Vinesh Phogat, who was very strong in defense and took advantage of the only moment of weakness of the Antillean to take an irreversible advantage before a crowded Campo de Marte.

In this same day of semis and finals, Gabriel Rosillo, representative of Greco-Roman wrestling in the 97 kilograms, also competed for the Island, who lost (3-5) against the Armenian Artur Aleksanyan, so he will also have to go for bronze this Wednesday.
