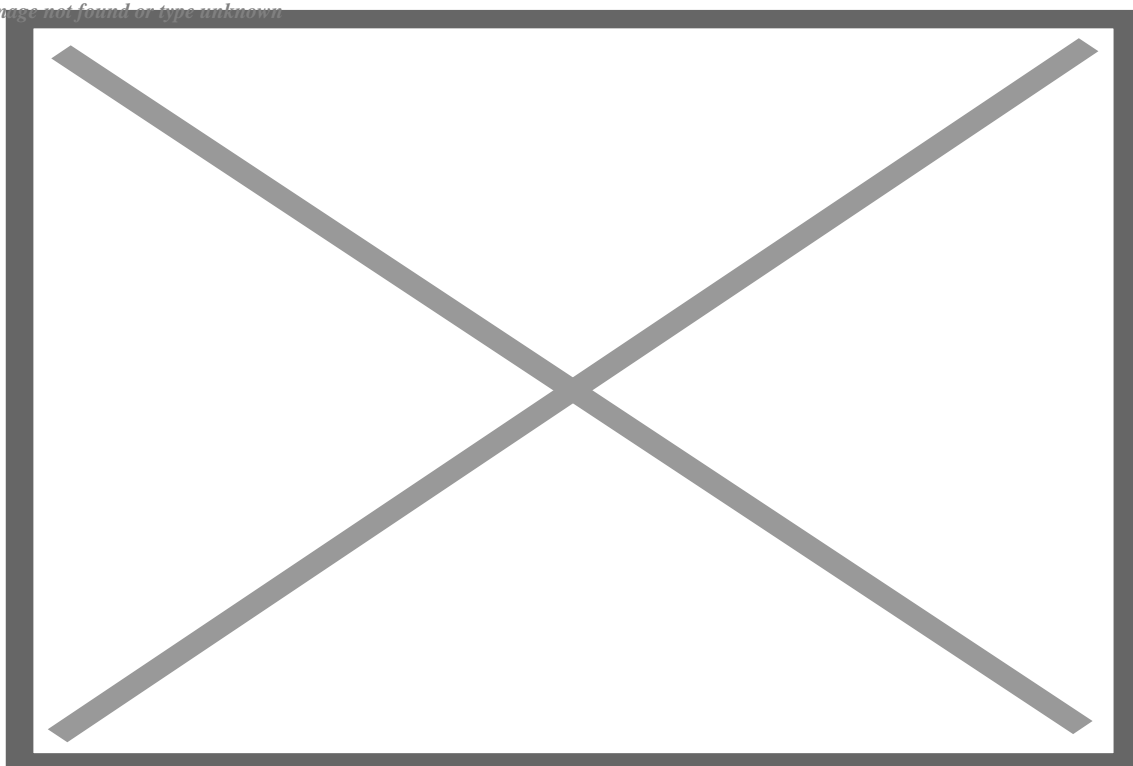


Fidel lives in the ability of culture to save humanity
