Cuba and Ethiopia discussed bilateral and multilateral issues

Havana, September 10 (RHC) The charge d'affaires of the Cuban embassy in Ethiopia, Natalys Dinza, spoke today with the general director for America and Europe of the local Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Zenebe Kebede, on issues of bilateral and multilateral interest.

Kedebe highlighted the ties of friendship between both countries and Havana's position in defending issues related to Addis Ababa in international forums.
