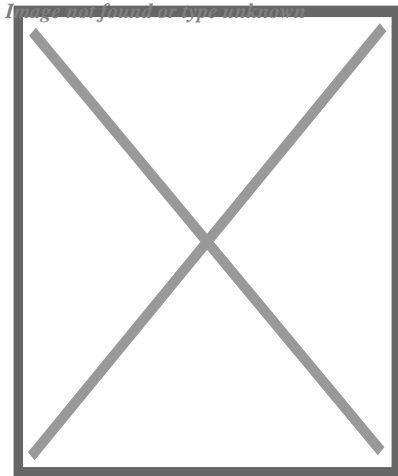


Global Climate Strike demands justice and end to fossil fuels
