
Cuban President Diaz-Canel meets with secretary general of the National Regeneration Movement Party, Morena, of Mexico



Mexico City, September 30 (RHC) -- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel held a meeting today, Monday, with the secretary general of the National Regeneration Movement Party (Morena), Carolina Rangel.

On his X account, the Cuban president reported that during their dialogue, they exchanged views on the excellent relations of the Mexican political organization with the Communist Party of Cuba and the importance of continuing to deepen them in this new stage.
