

Cuban foreign minister denounces Israeli genocide against children in Gaza

Havana, November 5 (RHC)-- More than 50 children died in two days due to the indiscriminate Israeli bombings in Gaza that even hit a Palestinian anti-polio vaccination center, Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno

Rodriguez denounced on Tuesday.

The head of Cuban diplomacy reiterated in X that the actions of the Zionist government constitute a serious violation of International Humanitarian Law, and that this is part of the genocide that Israel has committed with impunity in Palestine for more than a year.

In recent weeks, the defense forces of the Hebrew country have carried out a new offensive in northern Gaza, which has claimed the lives of hundreds of people and displaced tens of thousands.

According to news reports, the Israeli army recently launched a drone attack on a local clinic where children were being vaccinated against polio, leaving six people injured, including four minors.

Data from humanitarian organizations and the United Nations system show that, since the conflict broke out on October 7, 2023, when the Hamas armed group attacked and took hostages in Israel, the Zionist response has already claimed the lives of some 43,000 people, more than half of them women and children.
