
Liverpool deepens City's crisis in English football



London, Dec 1 (PL) Liverpool further deepened Manchester City's crisis by defeating them today by two goals to nil in the continuation of the English Football League.

Dutchman Cody Gakpo scored in the 12th minute for Liverpool and Egyptian Mohamed Salah completed the scoring with a penalty in the 78th minute.

With this result, the Reds are now in first place in the Premier League, with 34 points, nine ahead of Arsenal, their closest rival.

Meanwhile, champions City are in an unexpected fourth position and continue their negative streak with six consecutive defeats in all competitions.

Earlier, Chelsea beat Aston Villa 3-0 and Manchester United beat Everton 4-0, while Tottenham Hotspur and Fulham drew 1-1.
