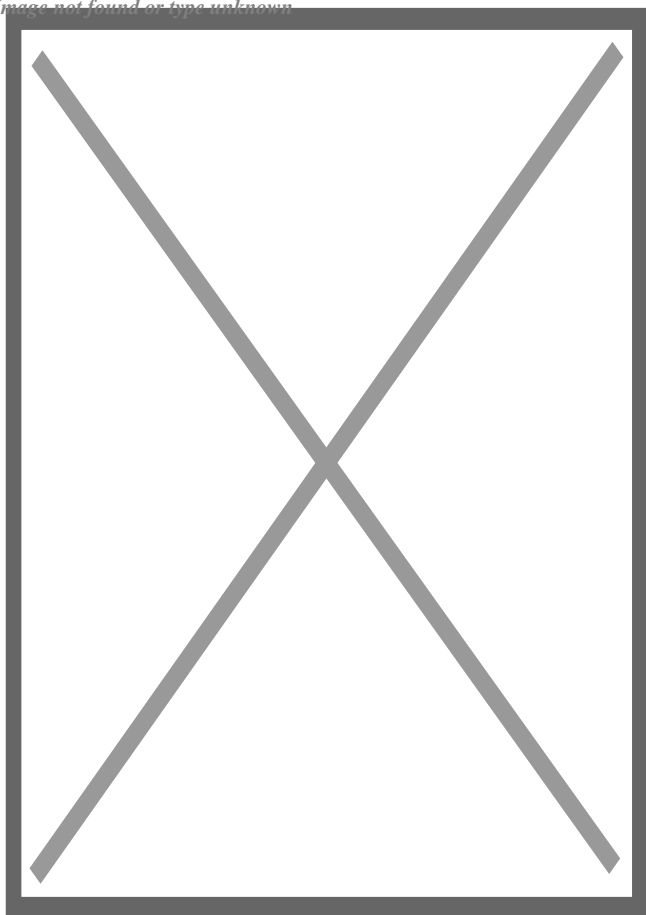


Happy New Year! Celebrating the 66th anniversary of the Cuban Revolution!
