Cuba Presents Tourist Offers to Attract Spanish Visitors



Havana, October 24 (RHC) — Cuba as a sun and beach tourist destination was promoted in the northern Spanish cities of Vigo, Oviedo and San Sebastián.

At a series of presentation held in those Spanish communities, spokespeople with the Cuban Ministry of Tourism provided details of the development of tourist infrastructure in sites such as the Jardines del Rey Keys, a place worthy to earn a name as *a postcard*-sized *tropical paradise*.
