
U.S. and Cuba veterans to play baseball game



Havana, Jan 7 (PL) Veterans from Cuba and the United States will hold two friendly baseball games in the capital's Latin American stadium, the Cuban Federation of this sport announced today.

For next Saturday, January 11, and Sunday, January 12, at 10:00 a.m. local time, the challenges are scheduled to take place on the field of the mythical stadium, where sports glories of the Antillean nation and members of the U.S. team Expo Maine will take part.
