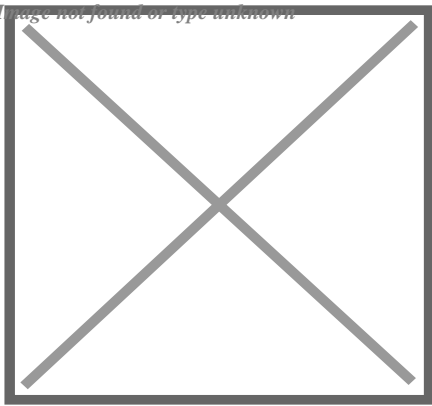

Havana, February 23 (RHC) -- Cuban President Miguel Díaz-Canel thanked China on Saturday for its willingness to continue collaborating with the Caribbean nation in key sectors such as energy and food production.
