

Cuba denounces new visa restrictions for the United States

Havana, February 25 (RHC) -- Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez has denounced the decision announced today on the suspension of visas associated with Cuba's international medical cooperation agreements.

"This represents the seventh measure of unjustified aggression against our population in a month. Marco Rubio once again puts his personal agenda ahead of the interests of the United States," said the Cuban foreign minister in X.
