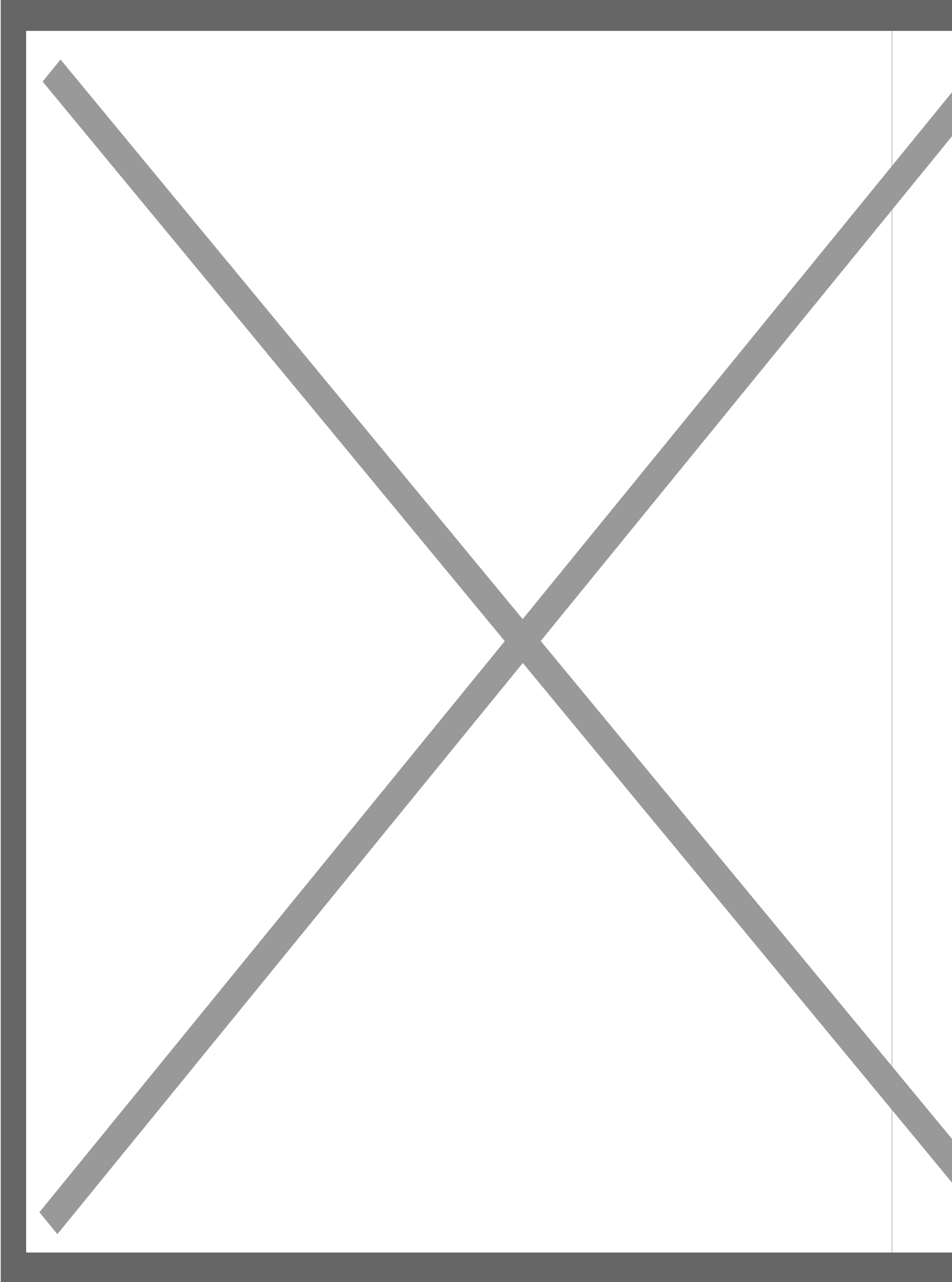


*Special panel discussion in New

New York, March 5 (RHC)-- A panel discussion will be held in New York City on Thursday, March 13th: "Ending the War on Women."

With the participation of expert panelists, the discussion will explore the intersections of gender, race, economic and political oppression -- shedding light on the unique yet interconnected battles women face in a context played by war and violence against women.

The panel will be facilitated by Claudia De la Cruz, theologian, popular educator and Executive Director of IFCO/Pastors for Peace.
