

JD Vance to join delegation headed to Greenland amid Trump threats to seize territory

Washington, March 27 (RHC)-- Vice President JD Vance has announced in a social media video that he will join a high-level Trump delegation going to Greenland this week following President Trump's threats to seize the semi-autonomous territory from Denmark.

Vice President JD Vance: "Speaking for President Trump, we want to reinvigorate the security of the people of Greenland because we think it's important to protecting the security of the entire world.

Unfortunately, leaders in both America and in Denmark, I think, ignored Greenland for far too long.

That's been bad for Greenland. It's also been bad for the security of the entire world. We think we can take things in a different direction, so I'm going to go check it out."

On the delegation, Vance will join his wife, second lady Usha Vance, national security adviser Michael Waltz and Energy Secretary Chris Wright. Greenland and Denmark have accused the United States of putting unacceptable and aggressive pressure on Greenland by sending the uninvited delegation.
