Cuban and Red Cross delegations hold high-level dialogue in Havana



Havana, March 27 (RHC)-- Delegations from Cuba and the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) began the tenth edition of the High-Level Dialogues in Havana this Wednesday, the Cuban Foreign Ministry reported.

According to the source, the meeting, which will run through Thursday, aims to deepen exchanges on issues of mutual interest related to the promotion and defense of International Humanitarian Law (IHL).
