Cuba, United Kingdom to Relaunch Bilateral Relations



Havana, Nov 1, (RHC), – The vice-president of the Council of Ministers of Cuba, Ricardo Cabrisas; and the Minister of State at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Commonwealth of the United Kingdom, Hugo Swire, expressed their interest in reviving bilateral relations.

In a meeting held yesterday in Havana's Palace of the Revolution, both senior representatives stressed they are working to develop the potential of the existing cooperation, reported Prensa Latina News Agency.

The Cuban representative stated that Swire's official visit comes at the right moment, as the island develops the projection of its economic development for the period 2016-2030, and gives priority to its plans until 2020.

In that sense, we are preparing for a trade delegation composed of prominent businessmen to come here next year, the minister pointed out.

There are very good investment opportunities in Cuba for British companies, stated the official while taking into account the Cuban context marked by the new Foreign Investment Law designed to attract foreign capital.
