

Cuban Foreign Minister Welcomes Chinese State Counselor



Havana, November 28 (RHC) -- Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodriguez met in Havana on Thursday with the State Counselor of the People's Republic of China, Yang Jing, who arrived yesterday on an official visit.

During the meeting, both officials ratified the excellent state of diplomatic relations and praised the great potentials for expansion of economic and cooperation links.
