

Cuban Communist Party Leader Meets Jamaican Politicians



Havana, February 6 (RHC) — The Second Secretary of Cuba's Communist Party, Jose Ramon Machado, met on Thursday in Havana with the vice president of Jamaica's People's National Party (PNP), Angela Brown-Burke, who is paying a visit to the island.

Brown-Burke, also senator and mayor of Kingston since 2012, exchanged views with the Cuban party leader about the work of their political organizations and about the current international scenario.
