

Cuban First Vice President Stresses Role of Community Work



Santa Clara, February 23 (RHC)-- Cuba's First Vice President Miguel Diaz Canel stressed the significance of community work amid current transformations in the country, in which the people must be the protagonists of every action.

The top Cuban official presided over the 14th Session of People's Power Provincial Assembly in the central province of Villa Clara.

Diaz-Canel underscored the need of joint work by families, education professionals and the rest of community actors to build a prosperous and sustainable socialism.
