

Foreign Health Ministers at International Health Convention Praise Cuba's Achievements



Havana, April 25 (RHC)-- Health Ministers of more than 40 countries who attended the just concluded International Convention on Public Health CubaSalud 2015 coincided in highlighting Cuba's health achievements and voiced their interest in further expanding and strengthening health cooperation with the Caribbean island country.
