

Namibia's Sam Nujoma Considers Essential Exchange between Cuban-Namibian Youth



Windhoek, May 19 (RHC) — The historical leader and first president of Namibia, Sam Nujoma, considered as essential the exchange between the new generations of Cubans and Namibians to preserve the strong friendship between both nations.
