Cuban Anti-terrorists Tour Places of Interest in Holguin



Holguin, May 28 (RHC)-- Two of the five Cuban anti-terrorists who served unfair prison terms in US jails, toured places of historical and social interest in the western province of Holguin.

During a meeting with local journalists and intellectuals, the two Cuban anti-terrorists Ramón Labañino and René González spoke about their experiences while in US prison.

René González again took the opportunity to thank Holguin residents and the entire Cuban people for embracing the Cuban Five's cause and never quitting the fight for their release.

In Holguin, the two Cuban anti-terrorists visited the house where Fidel and Raúl Castro were born, higher education centers, hospitals, facilities associated with the nickel industry and others linked to the growing tourism sector.
