

Cuban Defense Minister Visits Venezuela



Havana, June 23 (RHC) -- The Cuban Minister of the Revolutionary Armed Forces, Army Corps General Leopoldo Cintra Frias, is paying a working visit to Venezuela, where he was welcomed by his counterpart General in Chief Vladimir Padrino.

General Padrino said that it is a high honor for Venezuela to welcome the Cuban minister amid the historic commemoration of the 194th anniversary of the Carabobo Battle and the constant challenge in maintaining the way to democracy, justice, peace and defending the project of the Bolivarian Revolution.
