

# *France Summons U.S. Envoy After WikiLeaks Reveals NSA Spied on Presidents*

Paris, June 24 (RHC)-- France has summoned its U.S. ambassador following revelations by WikiLeaks that the United States has spied on the past three French presidents.

Documents published by WikiLeaks show the National Security Agency spied on President François Hollande and his two predecessors from 2006 to 2012, including listening to and recording cellphone conversations.

The revelation follows prior disclosures by Edward Snowden that the United States bugged German Chancellor Angela Merkel's cellphone.
