

Cuban Deputy Foreign Minister Concludes Visit to Zimbabwe



Harare, June 26 (RHC) -- Cuban Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs, Rogelio Sierra, wrapped up a visit to Zimbabwe, where he ratified the historic bonds of friendship and cooperation between Cuba and the African nation.
