Cuban Lawmakers Will Address Fight Against Corruption and Illegalities



Havana, July 1 (RHC) — Cuban lawmakers will analyze the results of the fight against crime, corruption, illegalities and social indiscipline at the Cuban Parliament session, which is slated for July 15th.
