

Hack of U.S. Government Data Impacted 21.5 Million



Washington, July 11 (RHC)-- The Barack Obama administration has acknowledged a breach of government computer systems was far worse than they initially disclosed.

Hackers stole information including fingerprints and Social Security numbers from 21.5 million people. The Office of Personnel Management said everyone who received a government background check over the last 15 years was likely impacted.
