Indigenous Confederation Expresses Support for Ecuadorian Government



Quito, August 7 (RHC) — The Confederation of Indigenous Peoples and Peasant Organizations of Ecuador voiced its support for the Citizen's Revolution project promoted by the government of President Rafael Correa, and his call for a national dialogue to resolve political disagreements.
