

Cuban President Raúl Castro Receives UNESCO Director General Irina Bokova



Havana, September 19 (RHC)-- Cuban President Raúl Castro met Friday with Director General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) Irina Bokova, who is on an official visit to the Caribbean state.

During the meeting, which was also attended by Cuban Foreign Minister Bruno Rodríguez, President Castro and the visiting top UNESCO official talked about the 3rd Meeting of Culture Ministers of the Community of Latin American and Caribbean States (CELAC), which is currently holding sessions here in the Cuban capital.
