

Fire, Riot and Rubber Bullets Cause Two Deaths and 49 Injuries in Peruvian Prison



Lima, October 12 (RHC-EFE)-- Two inmates were killed and 49 others injured in a fire at a Peruvian prison. The fire started around 2:30 a.m. on Saturday during a dispute involving two groups of inmates. One prisoner doused another inmate, identified as Frank Sanchez, with liquid gasoline. Fourteen inmates were injured in the blaze and three of them are listed in serious condition. One of the injured inmates, identified as Jaime Gil, died while being treated in a hospital. The fire triggered a fight that ended in a riot, the Ombudsman's Office said. Guards and police managed to regain control of the prison after a protest that
