

Protests Across the U.S. Demand Action on Climate Change



Washington, October 16 (RHC)-- Environmentalists held protests in cities across the United States, calling for action on climate change and protesting against the institutions that continue to drive fossil fuel extraction.

In Washington, D.C., activists held a die-in and a march on the American Petroleum Institute to demand a clean energy economy.

In Normal, Illinois, activists gathered in front of the office of a local official to demand a plan to move toward renewable energy.

In New York City, about 100 protesters gathered in front of JPMorgan Chase's office in Manhattan to protest the bank's investments in fossil fuel companies.
