

Indigenous Women from the Americas Meet to Discuss Struggles

Guatemala City, November 17 (teleSUR-RHC) -- Women leaders and members of indigenous communities from the Americas meet to discuss their struggles.

The continental meeting, to be held from Nov. 16 to 19, brings indigenous women from 20 countries to Guatemala.

"We need to hear and exchange views with our allies to build more inclusive, effective and sustainable models of development," said the president of the Continental Network of Indigenous Women of the Americas, Rosario Chinchilla.

The forum is organized by the Continental Network of Indigenous Women of the Americas (CNIW).

Indigenous delegates attending the forum belong to more than 100 indigenous groups.

Among the main themes of the forum, the women will discuss the detrimental effects of climate change on their communities.
