Venezuelan Lawmaker Denounces Coup Plots by Rightwing Sectors



Caracas, January 28 (RHC)-- Diosdado Cabello, Deputy of the Venezuelan National Assembly for the United Socialist Party of Venezuela (PSUV) has denounced new coup plots by right-wing sectors.

Cabello said enemies of the Bolivarian Revolution are using the country's current economic crisis as a pretext to prompt foreign intervention and overthrow the legitimate government of President Nicolás Maduro.

In his regular TV show '**Con el Mazo Dando'** the Venezuelan lawmaker compared the current situation in Venezuela with events occurred in the country in 2000, saying that opposition sectors are trying hard to portray a distorted, chaotic image of the South American country.

Cabello denounced also the double standard of the opposition-controlled parliament, which rejected the economic emergency decree presented by Maduro on January 15th to try to solve the country's economic problems.
