Cuba and the DPRK Sign Commercial Protocols



Havana, January 29 (RHC)-- Cuba and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) signed on Thursday two protocols of international cooperation, on trade and scientific and technical development, the Prensa Latina news agency reported.

The promotion of the exchange of goods in the Barter modality between the two states, primarily for inputs for the benefit of the Railroad Union of the Caribbean country to favor the island's sugar industry, was established with the signing of the two documents, by Rodrigo Malmierca, Minister of Foreign Trade and Investment, and Pak Chang Yul, ambassador of the DPRK in Cuba.
