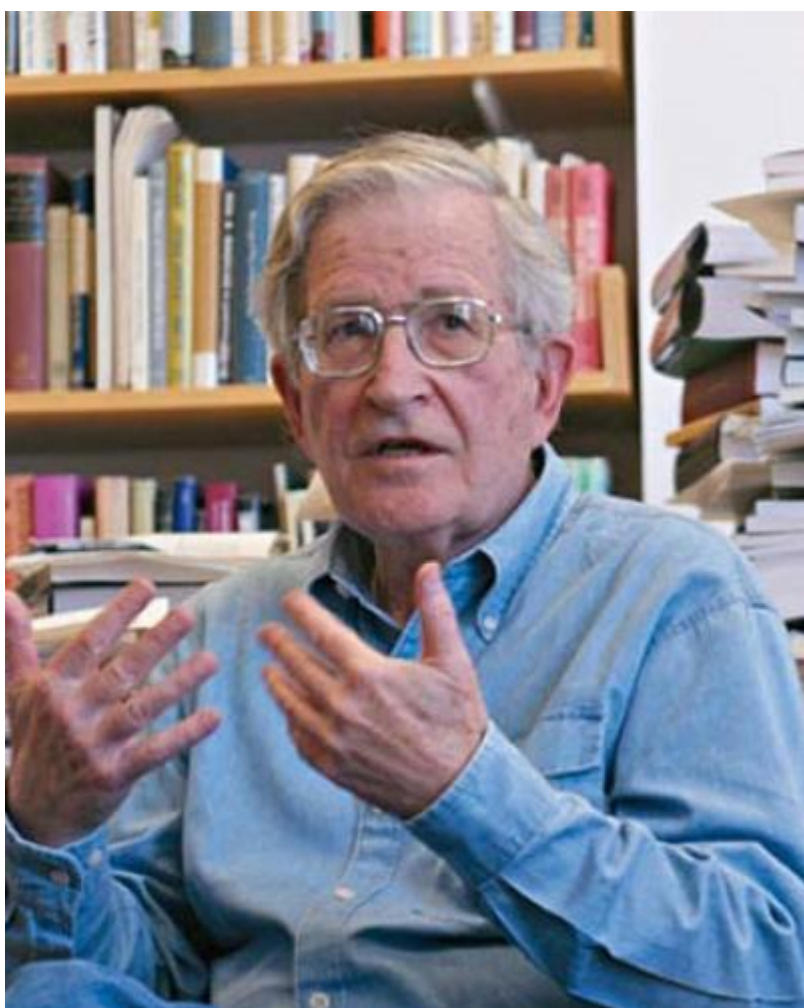


Noam Chomsky Says Donald Trump's Rise Due to Fear and Societal Breakdown
